Tier 3: Tertiary Interventions 1-5%

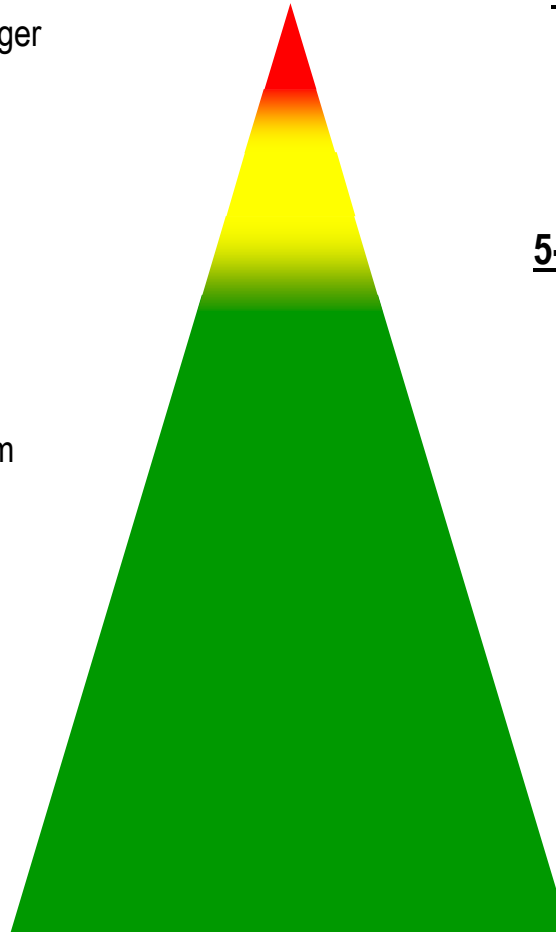
- DHHS, Child Protection, Child FIRST, Case Manager
- Regional Student Wellbeing, LOOKOUT Support
- Care Team Meeting

Tier 2: Secondary Interventions 5-15%

- Psychologist, Social Worker, Case Management
- Youth Worker, Speech Pathologist, KESO
- Visiting Teacher, Network Coordinator
- Parent Advocacy, Medical Specialist
- Consultation with Regional Student Wellbeing Team
- SSG, Housing Support Services

Tier 1: Universal Interventions 80-90%

- Parenting Support Networks, School Based or External Mentor
- Student Wellbeing Coordinator, Primary Wellbeing Officer, Principal Team
- School Based Student Support Service Officer
- Student Welfare Team
- Class Teacher, Education Support Officers



Staged Response for Classroom Management

1-5% Tier 3: Tertiary Interventions

- Alternative Settings, Inpatient CAMHS
- Safety Plan, PSD Review
- OOH Agreement, Functional Behaviour Assessment

5-15% Tier 2: Secondary Interventions

- Individual Learning Plan, Behaviour Management Plan,
- Cognitive, Paediatric & Speech Assessment
- Educational Assessment, Referral to Community Agencies, SSG, Autism Connect
- Mental Health Care Plan, PSD

80-90% Tier 1: Universal Interventions

- It's Not Ok to be Away, Bully Busters
- Language Support Program, Inclusion Online, Differentiation, School Nurse
- Marrung Education Plan, Positive Partnerships, Respectful Relationships
- Protective Behaviours, Mind Matters
- Literacy/Numeracy Programs
- Circle Time, Restorative Practices
- SWPBS, Calmer Classrooms
