
Student Support Group Meetings (SSG)

These are held twice a term to review your child's progress towards their goals. Parents/ caregivers, teachers, school representatives and other support staff all contribute to the development of Behaviour Support and Personalised Learning Plans. These meetings are held at the mainstream school.

School Operations

The YarraMe School operates classes from 9:00 a.m. until 2:45 p.m.

Students arrive at school no earlier than 8:50 a.m. Students have a morning recess break of thirty minutes and a lunch break of thirty minutes.

Senior Program

Years 4 to 6

Our School

The Senior Program offers a personalised Social and Emotional Learning program. Circle Time and social skills classes provide opportunity for social development and are integral elements of Positive Behaviour Supports. Time is also allocated daily for SMART goal setting and student self-evaluation.

All students are provided with a personalised learning and behaviour support plan on completion of the program. Small groups, predictable routines and appropriately modelled behaviour are inclusive of the safe and supportive environment.

The Senior Program caters for students in Years 4-6 providing a learning intensive for students who are exhibiting significant social and emotional regulation challenges. YarraMe School uses therapeutic and crisis prevention strategies to manage student behaviour, such as functional plans behaviour and safety management plans.

The School Wide Positive Support framework is in place across our school. The therapeutic approach used by our educators addresses both the emotional and cognitive development together, and is supported by a wraparound process to best meet the needs of each student.

We work in partnership with referring schools, families and caregivers to develop a strengths-based model to improve learning engagement. YarraMe School specialist psychologist and speech pathologist consult to help us diagnose and address specific behavioural and learning difficulties.

Placements

Placement in the program is for six months (two school terms). Students can be referred for a 1st Semester placement or a 2nd Semester placement. We enrol two groups over the course of the academic year.

Group 1 commences the program in Term One and completes the placement at the end of Term Two. Group 2 commences the program in Term 3 and completes the placement at the end of Term 4.
